Our journey



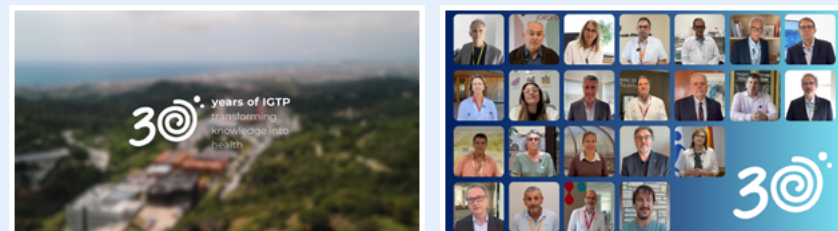
Over the past 30 years, the [Germans Trias i Pujol Research Institute \(IGTP\)](#) has evolved from early research initiatives linked to the Can Ruti Campus into a consolidated biomedical research institute within the Catalan and Spanish research systems.

This trajectory has been **defined by a strong commitment to translational research**, fostering close collaboration between researchers, clinicians and institutional partners, and contributing to improved health outcomes and knowledge generation.

Today, IGTP is recognised as a CERCA centre and an [Instituto de Investigación Sanitaria \(IIS\)](#) accredited by the Instituto de Salud Carlos III (ISCIII), reflecting its scientific excellence and impact.

30th anniversary of IGTP

Two commemorative videos have been produced for the 30th anniversary of IGTP: a retrospective of the institute's evolution, featuring past and current leadership together with members of the scientific and professional community, highlighting the shared vision, key milestones and institutional values that have shaped IGTP over three decades; and a compilation of congratulatory messages from institutional partners and collaborators, acknowledging IGTP's role in advancing biomedical research and its contribution to the research ecosystem.

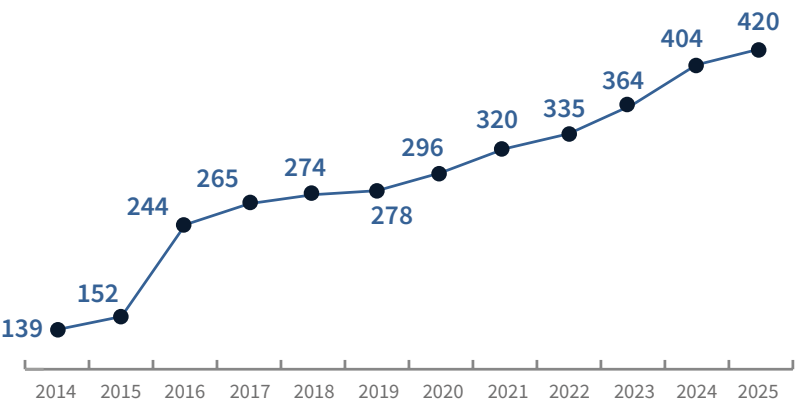
Our team

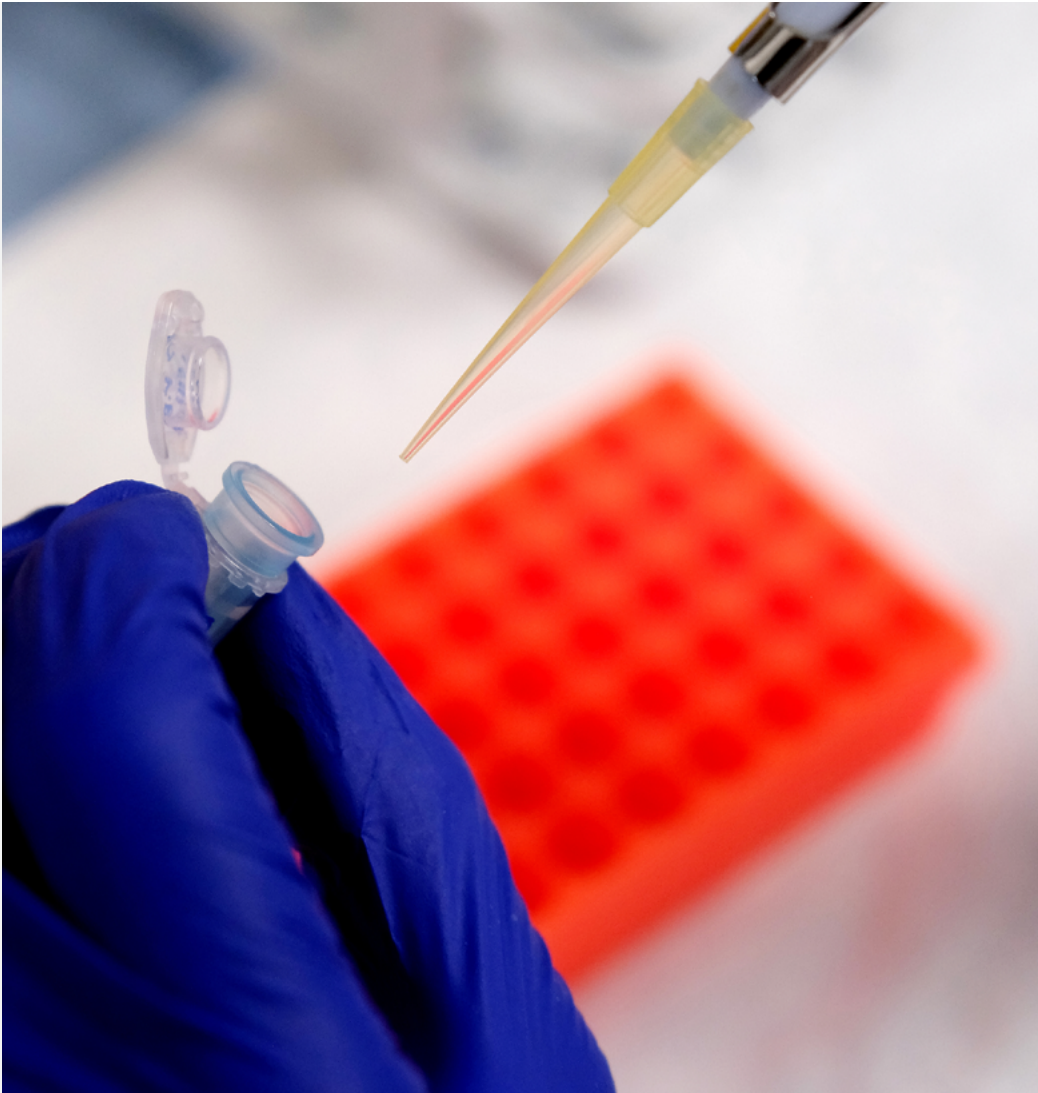
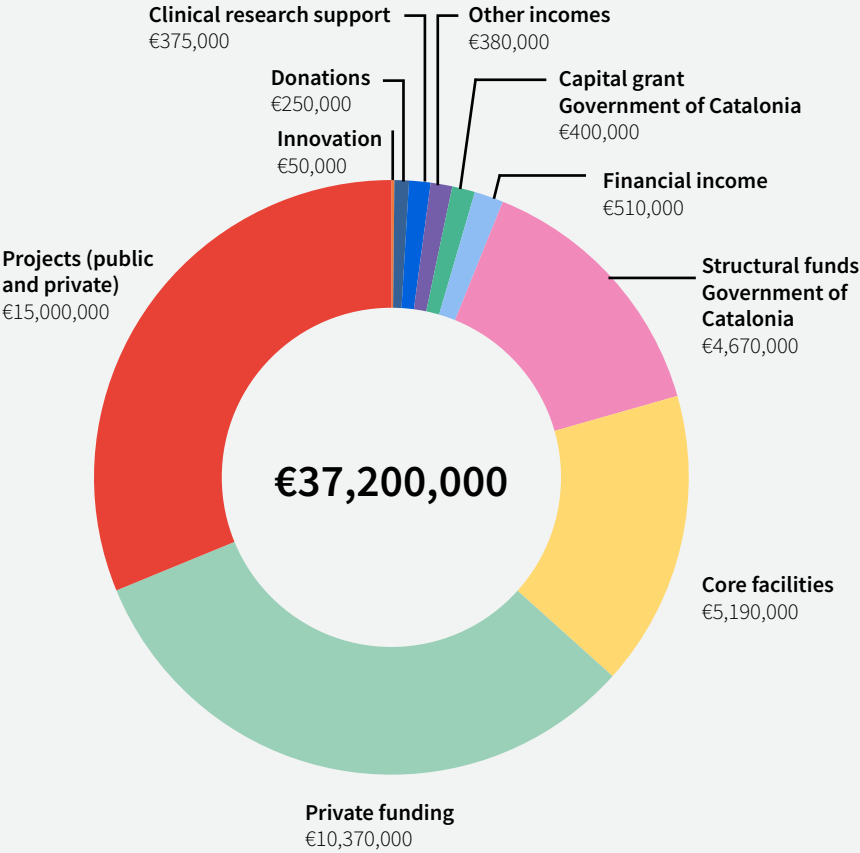

The Scientific-Technical Platforms (ICTS) at IGTP provide **centralised access to specialised equipment and expertise, supporting both internal research groups and external academic and private partners.** These platforms are supported by Fundació I-CERCA through the CERCAGINYS program, funded by the Spanish Ministry of Science, Innovation and Universities.

In 2025, the ICTS continued to contribute to improving access to high-level facilities across the research community while also fostering collaboration with the private sector and promoting the use of their services by industry. Among the year's highlights was the creation of the new [IGTP-IJC Joint Flow Cytometry Unit](#), presented at the second [Campus Can Ruti Core Facilities Infoday](#).
